
We also piloted the Access Finance Fund, our Entrepreneurship School and the Art Culture and Entertainment program. The programs provide the much needed financial and non-financial support to MSMEs. FINDING XY PROGRAMMES

Finding XY is implementing a number of programs to offer diversified services. These include;

Finding XY Entrepreneurship School

Finding XY Entrepreneurship School was built on the quest to boost entrepreneurship across borders through supporting entrepreneurs in the early and growth stages of business development. Entrepreneurs in the early stage are guided through the processes of understanding and challenging the key underlying assumptions of a business to successfully launch their enterprise. Those at the growth stage are supported in refining their business models to make their enterprises generate revenue and become investment-ready.

The sessions are conducted online which has given chance to entrepreneurs from all walks of life to tap into this opportunity.

Entrepreneurs are therefore not limited to

local networks. Two cohorts have so far enrolled and successfully completed the training and will graduate on 13th November, 2020. By the end of 2020, we will launch the elearning version of the school.

Besides training and mentoring participants, Finding XY Entrepreneurship School works directly with these MSMEs to understand their financial needs and provides appropriate financing options suitable for each enterprise through the Finding XY Access Finance Fund (AFF). Participating in the class has several benefits like Kick-starting their entrepreneurship journey. access to finance through AFF, developing a functional business model, developing a bankable business plan, developing leadership skills, networking with like-minded entrepreneurs and experts in the field, and access to Finding XY team of experts & coaches for continuous business support.







Artistic Culture & Entertainment (ACE)

ACE is a business training program preparing creative industry professionals (early and mid-stage) to lead today's local creative industry using high growth enterprise principles, as impact-driven visionaries and entrepreneurs. The program prepares creatives to be impact driven and goal-oriented.

ACE Program acknowledges the power of the creative industry as an economic empowerment tool for many African youths through employment and acts on this empowerment opportunity by introducing proper step by step guidelines to make this empowerment a reality. With ACE, unstructured, informal creative solopreneurs become structured, goal-oriented creative enterprises, employing more creatives into their high growth journeys while tracking the positive impact they create as a result.

The creative disciplines considered (without restriction to age) include; Art (Digital and Contemporary), Sports, Heritage, Fashion Design, Music and Film. These disciplines have a high rate of content/product output they bear and high demand by wider market segments (local, regional and global).

The Program has some objectives like promoting creatives, increasing profitability for creative entrepreneurs, growing market reach for creatives, greening creative entrepreneurs in their visions and operations, transitioning creative industry players into structured enterprises that create mass employment vehicles for the youth.

Through the Program, creatives get further access to an extensive network of connections, business tools and support by Finding XY that helps them to foster innovative ways to drive the future of the creative industry in the region.

Access Finance Fund (AFF)

The Access Finance Fund was established to provide unsecured growth financing to MSMEs with a ticket size \$500 to \$50,000. Such loans support, working capital and operational expenditures.

Our vision is to be the leading provider of capital to the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises in East Africa and beyond. With a mission of providing easy access to capital through Impact loans to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) through understanding our clients' needs and provision of the best financing option to our clients.

The overall objective of AFF is to ease access to affordable finance by MSMEs and to promote sustainable business operations and growth avenues

The Fund works directly with MSMEs to understand their financial needs and then provides appropriate financing options suitable for each enterprise. In addition, AFF extends professional Business Advisory services (BDS) to the Enterprises through the Finding XY Entrepreneurship School . The selected enterprises receive continuous mentoring and coaching to develop their capacities in the areas of leadership, strategic management, while building strong and meaningful Partnerships for the enterprises.

Our focus is on debt financing because access to debt finance for many MSMES has been a great challenge. We want to finance working capital to enable MSMEs fulfilling pressing contracts or projects.. The interest on the loans is marginally ranging between 10-15 percent depending on the enterprise risk assessment. The payment periods are agreed with the entity. Debt is provided for the periods not exceeding 18 months years. All enterprises that receive financing from AFF always receive expert support in the areas that are relevant and or unique to each enterprises' success.





Uganda Green Enterprise Finance Accelerator (UGEFA)

Uganda Green Finance Accelerator (UGEFA) is a European Union (EU) funded project aimed at improving access to finance for Green Enterprises through facilitating tailored loans and direct acceleration support. The 4-year project was launched on 10th March 2020 during the EU Business Forum with adelphi research gGmbH as the implementing partner in collaboration with SEED and Finding XY. SEED is a global programme that supports the growth of eco-inclusive enterprises. Adelphi hosts SEED in Germany.

UGEFA lowers the cost of financing by partnering with financial institutions to co-create green funding facilitation mechanisms for green SMEs. In order for green enterprises to benefit from this funding, they go through the UGEFA catalyser where we ensure the pipeline to be presented to the banks is bankable. Green SMEs that receive loans from partner banks get to have their loans discounted by upto 25%. They also receive extended support through the UGEFA accelerator program where we support their growth and investment plans.

UGEFA activities

- Catalyzer Program which prepares green enterprises with growth potential to bring their solutions to scale through interactive group-level training.
- Accelerator Program that supports green enterprises after loan approval to invest the funding through tailored one-on-one advisory.
- Funding Facilitation mechanisms structured in partnership with Financial Institutions to provide access to loans tailored to green business growth.
- Green and Climate Finance Trainings targeting financial institutions to build the case for green SME financing and to leverage opportunities for green and climate finance.
- Green Finance Dialogue Forums which is a platform for networking and exchanging insights on green and climate finance, based on interactive and innovative formats and workshops.
- UGEFA BDS+ TOT where we build a community of top-tier Business
 Development Advisors through participatory Training of Trainer workshops and tried and tested toolkits with financial institutions that address challenges in financing green SMEs, making the case for green SME financing.



SEED UGANDA

Finding XY hosts SEED Uganda hub with the objective of continuing and tailoring climate-smart enterprise programs in Uganda. SEED is a global partnership for action on sustainable development and the green economy. At SEED Uganda, we believe Eco-inclusive enterprises provide practical solutions to social and environmental problems that serve people at the bottom of the pyramid. They create a lasting collective impact in marginalised communities, eliminating poverty while tackling environmental issues.

SEED was founded at the 2002 World Summit on Sustainable Development in Johannesburg by UN Environment, UNDP and IUCN as a global partnership for action on sustainable development and the green economy. SEED is hosted by adelphi research gGmbH, a non-profit institution committed to sustainable development and entrepreneurship, based in Germany.

Some of the programs implemented through SEED this year include

SEED Accelerator

The SEED Accelerator Programme guides eco-inclusive enterprises who were selected as Winners in the SEED Awards to refine their business model in order to optimise their environmental, social and economic impacts and improve their investment readiness when scaling up. Through the SEED Accelerator programme, the SEED Awards Winners will receive a tailored support package based on the SEED Accelerator support. Tusafishe who were the SEED Award winner 2019 received accelerator training that helped them refine their growth plans and build a more consolidated team. The program was sponsored by the International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety (BMU).



SEED BDS+ Training of Trainers

SEED in partnership with Finding XY organized a FREE 3-day workshop on SEED Business Development Services (BDS+) Training of Trainers (ToT) on 'Eco-inclusive Enterprise Incubation'. This BDS+ ToT aimed at individuals who work at the interface of business, civil society and support businesses or entrepreneurial solutions in

Uganda. This training strived to have a diversified group of participants, balancing gender, and organizational representation. The workshop was sponsored by the International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety (BMU).



FINDING XY BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Online Dialogues

Finding XY facilitated online dialogues which were meant to offer advisory support to businesses during the COVID-19 pandemic. COVID-19 hit the global economy with SMEs' relatively feeling the pinch on a larger scale where most businesses were either paralysed or at the edge of collapse.

The first webinar took place on 28th of July 2020 with a theme of "How SMEs/businesses pivot their business models to survive the COVID-19 Crisis". Participants were enlightened on the need for pivoting to survive the economic repercussions of COVID-19. SEED Uganda also hosted online conversations in partnership with Sankalp Dialogues where we discussed ways of supporting SMEs survive COVID-19 crisis and unlock opportunities.
